

Acceptable Use Policy — Zeemage

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Language: Only the English version of this document is official and legally binding. Versions in other languages are unofficial convenience translations; in case of any discrepancy, the English version prevails.

This Acceptable Use Policy applies to all use of the Zeemage Service and supplements the Terms and Conditions. By using the Service, you agree not to:

- Upload or store content that is illegal in your jurisdiction or the jurisdiction where the content was captured.
- Use the Service to conduct surveillance of individuals in violation of applicable law, including covert surveillance of employees, tenants, or members of the public without required notice or legal basis.
- Upload content that infringes another person's privacy rights, intellectual property rights, or other legal rights.
- Use the Service to harass, stalk, or intimidate any individual.
- Attempt to circumvent, disable, or interfere with the security or proper functioning of the Service.
- Reverse engineer, decompile, or attempt to extract the source code of the Service, except where applicable law expressly permits this.
- Use the Service to transmit malware or engage in any activity that disrupts the Service for other users.
- Resell or provide third-party access to the Service in a way not authorized under your subscription plan.
- Use the Zeemage SMTP intake service for any purpose other than delivering camera content to your own Zeemage feed addresses.
- Circumvent or attempt to circumvent quotas, rate limits, fair-use limits, or share-link restrictions.

Enforcement

The Provider may suspend or terminate accounts that violate this policy, consistent with the termination provisions in the Terms and Conditions.
