

Cookie Policy — Zeemage

This Cookie Policy explains how Resolutio Nova Ltd ("Zeemage," "we," "us") uses cookies and similar technologies (including browser local storage) on our website and Service.

Cookies we set

None. Zeemage does not set any cookies of its own — sign-in and session handling are implemented without Zeemage-set cookies.

Local browser storage we use

In addition to cookies, the Service stores a small number of values in your browser's local storage. These work like cookies and are all functional:

Key	Purpose	Duration
zeemage-theme	Remembers your chosen color theme so the interface displays correctly	Persistent until cleared
zeemageFcmToken	Your browser's push notification token (Google Firebase Cloud Messaging), used to deliver notifications you have enabled	Persistent until cleared or notifications disabled
zeemage-lang	Remembers your language choice on the public pages	Persistent until cleared

If you enable push notifications, a background service worker is also registered in your browser to receive them.

Third-party services

Some pages load components from third parties, which may set their own cookies and receive your IP address under their own policies:

- **Stripe** (payment pages only): our payment provider loads Stripe.js for secure payment handling and fraud prevention, and the Stripe-hosted checkout sets Stripe's own cookies. These are necessary to process the payment you request.

- **Google / Apple sign-in** (login page): if you sign in with Google or Apple, their sign-in components operate under their own policies.
- **Google Firebase** (if notifications enabled): notification delivery infrastructure.

What we don't use

We do not use advertising cookies, third-party analytics cookies, or tracking cookies for marketing purposes.

Why no cookie banner

Under the EU ePrivacy Directive, consent banners are required for cookies that are not strictly necessary for the service you've requested (e.g. analytics or advertising cookies). Everything listed above is functional: sign-in, your saved preferences, notifications you enable, and payment processing you initiate. Because Zeemage uses no analytics, advertising, or marketing tracking, no consent banner is legally required — we disclose everything here for transparency.

If this changes

If we introduce analytics, advertising, or other non-essential cookies in the future, we will update this policy and implement a consent mechanism before doing so.
